

My name is Tim McLaughlin I am your child's Automotive Technology Instructor. I have 25 year of experience in the Automotive Technology field. I want to take this opportunity to welcome you and your student to the Automotive Technology program here at Butler County Area Vocational-Technical School. I have designed our program so that your student will be able to enter into the industry a step ahead of their peers.

The objectives for the students in Automotive Technology are as follows:

- To develop professionalism and work ethic in all assigned tasks
- To gain entry-level knowledge and understanding of equipment operations and systems
- To develop safe working habits and to work cooperatively with fellow classmates
- To acquire dependable and employable qualities for future employment
- To maintain professional presentation with a clean uniform and work area

In order to have your child remain safe in the shop area, I require the student to be prepared with the following items:

- 1. Information on student uniform shirts will be provided the first week of school.
- 2. Leather work boots with laces are necessary.
- 3. Black work pants or black jeans with no holes or frays in them.

I find that black pants are better to mask grease stains that can be hard to remove.

4. A keyed lock with two keys for your child's locker to secure their work attire in.

Work attire <u>must be kept a BCAVTS</u>. Work clothing <u>cannot be worn</u> to and from BCAVTS. These clothing requirements along with safety glasses are a <u>daily requirement</u> of class. Failure to comply jeopardizes your child's safety. Choosing to disregard these procedures will impact his/her grade.

- 5. Safety glasses
  - <u>Safety glass must be worn at all times in the shop area.</u> Students will be provided with their first set of safety glasses.
- Students will also need:
  - 1. 3" binder
  - 2. 1" binder w/clear front and side for portfolio
  - 3. Standard notebook

The breakdown of the overall grade in Automotive Technology is as follows. Daily Participation 30% Shop Work Grade 35% and Theory 35% (Homework, Test and Notes).
