While in the shop, the students are required to wear proper protective equipment at all times as and must follow the posted safety rules. Students will be required to bring in protective clothing such as work boots (steel toe NOT required) and work jeans (with no holes or tears). The school provides students with hard hats, hearing protection, and one pair of safety glasses If a student loses or destroys this pair of safety glasses, the student will have to purchase a new pair.
